



Dr. Ruth Seeler: The Facts

The Facts

s Director of Pediatric Education and a member of the Hematology Division at the University of Illinois, Chicago, Dr. Ruth Seeler (Vermont) is seeing the effect of the AIDS virus on the hemophiliac children she treats daily. "We know most hemophiliacs have been exposed to AIDS from blood transfusions that were given prior to 1985," she said, "and 2 percent of those exposed are symptomatic."

For every patient with AIDS it is estimated that 10 times as many have AIDS-related Complex (ARC), a precursor to the full-blown disease, and 50 times as many already have been infected with the agent Human Immodeficiency Virus (HIV) whose blood will test positive for antibody to HIV. This development in the blood of antibodies to the virus usually takes place within six months of infection. But the virus is a time bomb that may take many years to trigger disease symptoms.

Since 1985 all donated blood has been tested for the AIDS virus. The risk of contracting AIDS from a blood transfusion is remote because the high risk donors have been eliminated from those who provide six million transfusions annually. "We don't know how many kids actually have the virus," Ruth said, "since there has been no program to test those who donated blood prior to 1985."

Ruth's chief concern, since she runs an inpatient pediatric unit that cares for all hemophiliacs at the hospital, is children who now have AIDS. She noted they are more seriously ill than adults simply because they have not lived long enough to build up antibodies to bacterial infections of all kinds. Therefore, according to patients' ages, the infections they have are more serious, to the point that those infected with AIDS in utero are very very sick and often smaller than other newborns.

Regarding the contagious nature of the virus, Ruth said, "The fascinating thing is we have looked at brothers and sisters of symptomatic hemophiliacs as well as children of hemophiliac fathers. There is no intra-family spread of the virus to non-sexually active family members, even though when you go into the home you

find one glass in the bathroom. Or, as in any family, kids and parents eat leftover cookies or pieces of food from dinner plates. Even toothbrushes are used indiscriminately."

These home studies have convinced her that it is safe for AIDS children to be in school, and she spends an inordinate amount of her time in an effort to keep them there. By the same token, she has no qualms about running her camp for hemophiliacs where dishes and silver go through the dishwasher, even if they appear unused. She had to educate her camp staff and Board of Directors that rules already in place against the spread of hepatitis, infinitely more infectious than AIDS, were protection enough.

She added that the medical profession runs a low risk of contracting the virus, only a handful of cases appearing from accidental injury by an infected needle. The AIDS virus is very fragile and very hard to catch, requiring either a direct hit—or multiple hits—of contaminated blood from needles; or a direct hit—or multiple hits—of contaminated blood or semen from sexual intercourse. The sad exceptions are children born to mothers already infected with the virus.

What we do NOT know about AIDS is enormous, Ruth said. What we do know is that it is spread by: sexual relations; mothers—usually drug users and/or prostitutes—passing it to their unborn babies; sharing needles. And experts predict that within five years almost all Americans will personally know someone with AIDS and will be touched by the tragedy.

Here's how the virus works: A virus is insoluble. When it gets into the blood stream, it is spotted by white blood cells called phagocytes (Greek for "eater of cells") that literally chew it up. The white blood cells then report back to the command post, the T4 Cell, where pieces of the virus called viral antigens are presented. The T4 Cell then orders mobilization for war, calling upon two fighting divisions—B Cells named for bone marrow where they are manufactured, and T Cells, named for the thymus gland where they undergo additional processing.

T4 Cells produce a growth factor, Interleukin, that tells all cells of the immune army to multiply. The multiplying B Cells manufacture an antibody to attack the virus, called "antibody-mediated immunity." Multiplying T Cells include Killer T Cells and natural killer cells that attack the virus.

T4 Cells also send out a signal to activate T8 or suppressor cells that regulate the response of the immune system, preventing it from overkill. Without suppressor cells, the immune system might make antibodies forever and overdose on its own defense.

The B Division and T Division fight separately and collectively against the virus and, in the case of a cold, usually subdue it in a week or so.

HIV is different. It enters the body as an infected cell in blood or semen, the phagocyte rushes to it, ingests the HIV, and is surprised when it swallows it whole instead of breaking it up. So the white blood cell does not present a chewed up virus to the T4 Cell. Not only is the T4 Cell deceived, it becomes infected, too.

Once the T4 Cell is infected, the virus can hide out for years awaiting conditions that will enable it to take over, destroy the cell, and manufacture new viruses. The genetic material of the virus fuses with the genetic material of the host and remains forever. It is immortal. Once

infected, the body cannot be rid of this virus. Since T4 cells can go everywhere in the body, including crossing the blood-brain barrier, the virus can potentially be found anywhere. As the virus multiplies, it kills off the crucial T4 cells. As helper cells that normally outnumber suppressor cells fall in the minority, the immune system is destroyed, and the body is vulnerable to the diseases that define AIDS, those that seize on the opportunity of lowered immunity.

Most common signals of AIDS are *Pneumocystis* carinii pneumonia (PCP), a rare form of pneumonia, and Kaposi's sarcoma (KS), a rare cancer. Almost all Americans have been exposed to the protozoan that causes PCP by the time they are five years old, but the

was tested for AIDS last spring. It was a consequence of a one-time sexual contact with someone in a high-risk group. Someone who did not tell me he was a member of that high-risk group.

The mutual friend who introduced us warned me (too late, unfortunately) that I had been exposed. In my naivete I felt little fear even after my friend's alert. After all, I lived in a town in the midwest and the major cities reporting large numbers of AIDS patients were coastal (San Francisco, New York, Washington, D.C.). AIDS didn't intrude on my life . . . into my safe environment.

I was fortunate to have a physician to turn to . . . someone with a great deal of experience in the AIDS field. I expected maybe a lecture about being more careful and an assurance that I was fine . . . nothing to worry about.

His words stunned me: "You must be tested and anyone else you've had sexual contact with must be tested. If your original contact is HIV + (AIDS virus contracted, but patient is presymptomatic), your chances are 50-50."

He talked about the testing, possible results, test accuracy, the lifestyle change I would have to make if my test were positive, facts about the disease. His voice receded as if someone had slowly turned down the volume. My ears began to ring, my physical strength drained from my body and my chest felt compressed with a huge weight. Breathing became difficult as I faced the seriousness of my situation. The urge to deny what had happened . . . what could yet happen . . . was enormous. I wanted to run back to the safe, secure world I had lived in just a few moments ago.

Gradually over the next few hours, terror seeped through and replaced the shock. I had heard your life flashed before you when facing death. It's true, except mine replayed endlessly along with the losses of my future. Relationships I had let slip away or that needed mending . . . would there be time? Experiences I hadn't had . . . trips I hadn't made . . . would I be so sick I would lose those dreams and plans forever?

Taken-for-granted things moved into sharp focus. The grass never looked greener; the spring earth never smelled fresher. The knot in my stomach became constant and everyday activities (dressing, working, social interaction) demanded so much effort.

And the questions. All questions for which there were no answers yet. How long before I exhibited one of the opportunistic infections that signaled the onset of the AIDS symptoms? Statistics gave me two to eight years. Would I be very sick? Would there be much pain? Would I be able to take care of myself in the early phases? If they found out at work, would I be fired and lose my insurance? Would I be an outcast to acquaintances and co-workers? Would my family accept me and what had happened? And most importantly, despite a strong spiritual life, what would happen after death? I remember sobbing to a friend, "I'm so scared."

During my blood test I watched in renewed horror the extraordinary care the physician took while drawing my blood. Gloves, certainly, but the careful labeling and packaging of the sample . . . my sample . . . the disposal of the syringe and paraphernalia before degloving. I remember questioning, "where can I safely dispose of the cotton ball" I had held over the puncture point.

I mentioned to the physician that I had a pap test and dental checkup scheduled within the next few weeks. Was I endangering anyone else? His answer was slow in coming: "Probably not, but let's wait for the test results." I cancelled both appointments. Fear gripped my being in a vice that only loosened when I slept . . . when I could sleep.

Then there was the bargaining. Maybe a cure would be found before I became symptomatic. Maybe if I exercised more, ate right and took vitamins I could stave off the first opportunistic infection. Maybe the new treatments I'd read about in the paper would be approved soon by the Federal Drug Administration.

- Be a part of the special "sharing and caring" between members of Gamma Phi Beta.

Alumnae initiates have problems too.

To Gamma Phi Beta I am a member. There is no distinction or difference for alumnae initiates. Yet, sometimes I feel different. When my local alumnae group meets, members discuss "college days at the chapter house" and ask when I was at school.

I tell my story and feel sad I missed out on collegiate Gamma Phi Beta life. Others may ask, "Why would you want to join a sorority at your age?" Legacies are special people. They have a background interest in and loyalty to Gamma Phi Beta which could make them valuable members.

It has been Gamma Phi Beta's long-standing policy that chapters should give legacies fair and serious consideration during rush. Collegians should feel a special responsibility for legacies going through rush. Usually these women already are aware of the responsibilities of Gamma Phi Beta membership. This awareness, along with a deep sense of relationship to the Sorority, gives legacies a head start on the development of attributes which make for strong lifetime Gamma Phi Beta members.

Gamma Phi Beta relatives have responsibilities, too. They should notify the chapter by note or Legacy Introduction Form, and send a Sponsor Form.

However, alumnae must remember guaranteed pledging is not possible for every legacy. Many chapters have more legacies going through rush than places in their pledge classes. Alumnae also should keep in mind that women with varying interests and personalities will feel comfortable in chapters in different geographic locations at certain times.

normal immune system fights it off. Before AIDS, rare cases of KS were found in elderly men of Mediterranean descent, so singular an occurrence that one Chicago doctor had not seen a case in 20 years. Other predators are bacteria, cancers, fungi, infections, protozoa—and in at least one-third of the cases, the saddest: inflamation of the brain and progressive, fatal dementia.

AZT, an experimental drug that interferes with the way the AIDS virus reproduces itself, will soon be tried on children, since it has been okayed for adults. National studies are being devised, Ruth said, that will start with older children and be worked down to the younger, eventually to the newborn. But the drug is still experimental, costly (\$8,000-\$10,000 annually per patient), and has serious side effects, including anemia.

Ruth said no one can tell where it came from, but history of the disease shows that the epidemic developed hand in hand with the new promiscuity coupled with a drug culture that had progressed from the 1950's with heroin among poor blacks; to the 1960's with marijuana and LSD among young student radicals; to the 1970's with high potency marijuana and heroin popular among American soldiers fighting in Vietnam and with almost all drugs suddenly popular among affluent suburban kids; to the 1980's with cocaine and "designer drugs" among young urban professionals.

The epidemic proportions of AIDS came to the attention of the medical world in 1980-81, Ruth said, but politicians didn't pick up on the problem until later when the number of cases, exacerbated by the portion of the homosexual population that was promiscuous, started showing up faster. When the virus spread to i.v. drug users and prostitutes,

the epidemic became a public health issue. But gays and junkies did not create this virus. They are the current victims. "Remember that for every homosexual person there are nine to ten heterosexuals, so the epidemic is slowly invading the population at large. In time, the heterosexuals will outnumber the older risk groups," Ruth said. Today one quarter of all AIDS cases are sexually active heterosexuals. Also bisexual men are a major threat to spread AIDS into the heterosexual world, and they are a lot more numerous than once thought, according to the Chicago Tribune Sunday Magazine.

The epidemic is complex to manage, because AIDS has political, social, religious, and moral ramifications. AIDS stirs up primitive feelings, according to Northwestern university psychiatrist Nathan Birnbaum, quoted in the *Tribune Magazine*, because it involves all our taboos. It's contagious; it's incurable and fatal; it mainly strikes the young; and it is tied up with drugs, sex, morality. Also, it strikes the brain. It leaves nothing out. You could not invent a disease more likely to stir up anxiety among people.

Testing for the AIDS virus isn't necessary, Ruth feels, for those who are low risk (not sexually promiscuous or into the drug culture). It is impossible to tell the "false positive" (something else reacting in the blood sample) from the "real positive" unless a confirmatory test is done. And there is a concern that too stringent testing requirements will make high risk groups go underground, thus increasing the difficulty of studying the disease.

Ruth believes the only legitimate areas for government intervention into the crisis are to provide money for patient care, research and education. Anything more than that is very touchy as state and national government grapple with striking a balance between individual rights and the health and safety of the community.

So far as AIDS education in schools is concerned, Ruth says the schools must present both options: sexual abstinence or use of condoms. She echoes other professionals who say, "For now, our best weapon is education." Yet, others think education won't work, since we still smoke, drink and drive, and teenagers still get pregnant, despite best educational efforts.

Although we are closer to a breakthrough in our knowledge of the disease and some means of control now than she thought two years ago we would be, Ruth would not elaborate on that statement, saying the only way to stop the epidemic spread is to use prelubricated condoms with spermicidal jelly.

"Use of condoms is a lifesaving act, and we have to tell kids to protect themselves if they're going to have sex," Ruth said. To this end, she does a large amount of counseling on dating and use of contraceptives among her hemophiliac patients.

"This is not a time to experiment with intravenous drugs under any circumstances," she warned. "And, if you are going to sleep with someone, the best advice I can give is to establish a relationship for a long time, then use condoms."

The biggest problem with the AIDS virus is cultural, according to Ruth. Since the use of diaphragms and invention of the birth control pill, responsibility for contraception has been left in the hands of women. Telling users of contraceptives to switch to the condom, for which the male has responsibility, is asking for a "monumental societal change." College kids are especially good at promoting this change, however, she laughed, citing her own alma mater, where a condom was distributed one day in each issue of the student newspaper. She is also encouraged by the fact that drug stores now position condoms where they can be picked up rather than requiring customers to ask for them.

Women's role in the condom scenario is to carry them and insist that men wear them. AIDS should be a huge women's health issue, and so far it isn't. The risk of women acquiring AIDS from an infected male partner is 10 to 100 times the risk the other way around since semen carries much more of the virus than cervical or vaginal secretions. By 1991 as many as nine percent of AIDS cases may be women, according to the Tribune Magazine. If we ever develop a significant number of heterosexual women with the virus, we're facing disaster.

So the outlook for now is that the best efforts of science and medicine and profound alteration of our social lives and sexual practices can do little more than slow down the spread of the virus.

Five days later I received my test results. Negative. I was so fortunate. Not just in the fact that I had not contracted the AIDS virus but also in the affirmation of life that occurred and has remained with me. That appreciation of everyday small things, deepened feelings of love for family and friends, and humility in the face of my own shortcomings.

During the ordeal a friend said,

"no matter how the test turns out, you have choices of how you will live your life." Her words comforted me then and now. All of us have choices and choosing to be educated about AIDS and exercising caution with our lives are choices we all must make.
